IN ALL THINGS GIVE THANKS...

I have two young children.

Having young children is something that continually surprises me. I'm astounded by how the larger, seemingly miraculous observations that come from having children are awesome: the miracle of a new life, seeing your child grow and learn, and the love that wells up in one's heart.

However, some of the more surprising elements of parenthood have been found in the more mundane. I didn't realise how much of parenting was shaped by teaching the everyday habits we take for granted; that routines from the brushing of teeth to hand washing need to be constantly reminded.

We are at a stage in our house where every single request is prefaced with "and say P-P-P-Please" and every interaction ends with "and what do you say now... 'thank you'." Like many elements of parenting it has made me very aware of how much I obey what I'm trying to teach: the times I say 'thank you' and sometimes it highlights those times that I neglect it.

Thankfulness helps us remember our interdependence.

In a world that cries "you can do it" and "look after number one" crafting a habit of thankfulness means that we are continually reminded that we are all dependent on each other. Whether it be the emotional support a friend gives you, the help of a stranger or even the vast network of infrastructure we are dependent on.

Thanking a shop assistant is a reminder that my food is dependent on so many others. The staples of my life are not things that I am sole master over. I am reliant on the hard work, the enterprise and diligence of so many others.

Thankfulness helps us see embers when all seems dark.

A friend of ours was sat at her mum's hospital bedside; broken and devastated. Unable to see anything other than the person who had loved her most, seriously ill. She tells of running her hands over the crisp linen being thankful for how clean it was. Then thanking God for the fresh flowers someone

had put on the cabinet, thankful for the sunshine, thankful for all the good years, thankful for the influence of her parents, thankful for the things she had been taught and how her mum had passed on life skills to shape who she was and the life she now had.

Her grief was no less. The situation had not changed but her perspective had shifted. We all have seasons of darkness in life, for some of us this seems unending. It can become all encompassing but it is never the only thing.



Thankfulness grounds us in the present and also whispers of the impermanence of that which feels all encompassing now. Today's problem is not the only thing in the world. Even though it may be the most pressing, genuinely problematic and deleterious thing in one's life at this time. Tomorrow can be shaped by other things other than the problems of today.

Thankfulness allows us to usher into focus the small, almost hidden glimpses of a hopeful future.

Thankfulness shapes our future

The reason that I teach my children to say 'thank you' and be thankful is because it shapes who they are becoming and the lens through which they see the world. When I remember to be thankful I see the good in a bad situation. When this becomes a habit my life is shaped more by the good than the bad.

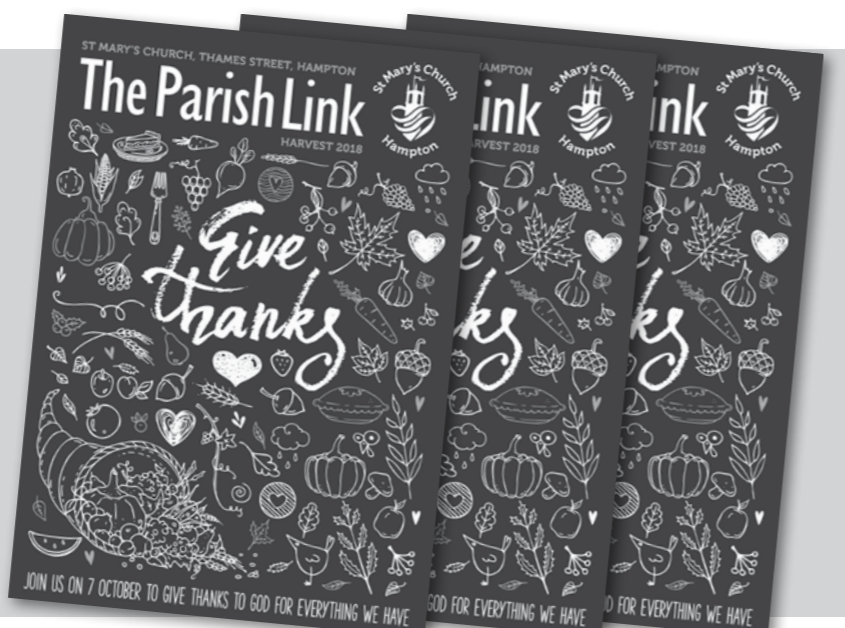
At Harvest we are called to be thankful. Our gratitude reminds us not to be focused on ourselves and the problems that surround us. Appreciation for what we have, however small, compels us to be generous. To live a life that looks beyond ourselves, that gives, that heals, that brings life to those around us.

World War One on Our Door Step 1918-2018

Hampton's War Memorial can be found inside St Mary's Church. It is a memorial to the men of Hampton who fell in the Great War, 1914-19. The names of those who fell in the Second World War were added subsequently in 1946. The 22 November 1919 issue of the Surrey Comet describes the War Memorial as 'a handsome oak screen erected in the parish church'. It is indeed very handsome and is adorned with carvings of our four national saints:

George, Andrew, Patrick and David. The carved inscription reads: These screens were erected to the glory of God and in grateful memory of the men of Hampton who fell in the War 1914-1919.

The list of names engraved on the screen is detailed below. Among the 136 names are three sons of the King family of Plevna Road. Frank King was killed in Arras on 11 April 1917, but it was not until 1996 that

his remains were found in the course of an archaeological survey of the area. Much effort was put into tracing his relatives and on 15 April 1998 – 81 years after his death – his remains were buried in a war cemetery close to the site of the battle. This is just one story behind one name on our War Memorial.

2018 has seen renewed interest in the memorial and the Parish Office has received many enquiries from people trying to trace where their ancestors are remembered. If you wish to come and see it, please contact us on 020 8941 7221 or email parish.manager@hampton-church.org.uk

The Hampton Mandimba Partnership

Plans are underway for a group of four members of St Mary's, led by Ben, to visit Mandimba in October in order to see first hand what the Hampton Mandimba Partnership has achieved and where funds are needed going forward. More importantly it's a good opportunity to strengthen our bond with our brothers and sisters in Mozambique.

We currently fund nursing training for two students and send funds to facilitate travel to both local hospitals and hospitals over the border in Malawi.

The Good Seeds Project continues to thrive. Since its launch in 2006 The Project has ensured that literally hundreds of young people have not had to drop out of school simply because they were poor. In Mozambique there is a small charge for secondary education – this is based on the principle that people appreciate what they have to pay for better than something that is free. However there are a great number of secondary school-aged children who are orphans and finding money for fees, a (compulsory) school uniform and stationery is just too much. St Mary's provides a modest amount for each Good Seed but it is adequate to keep them in school.

Bishop Vicente's Visit to Hampton

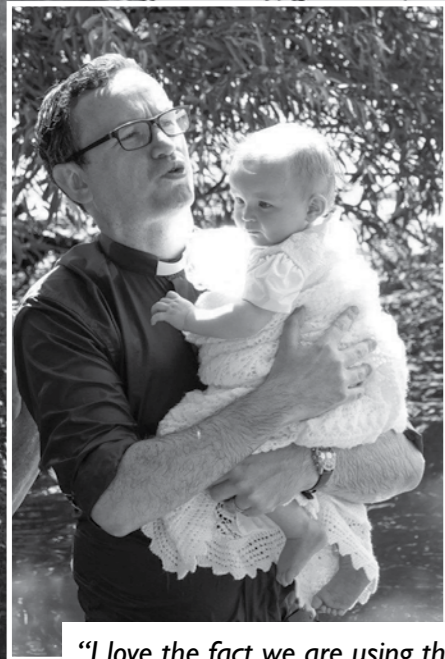
During the summer the Rt Rev Vincente Msoa, Bishop of Niasa, came to St Mary's and shared Evening Prayer with us. At the end of the service he talked about his ministry in Niasa Province, and in particular in Mandimba, our sister parish.

Bishop Vicente talked about the challenges of life in his diocese. These included a lack of Bibles (in local dialects as well as Portuguese) and a lack of priests to serve their community, which is vast. In Mandimba Father Austin serves six congregations but it is not unknown for some priests to look after as many as fifty congregations.

He was truly thankful for the friendship that Sao Paulo's Parish has with us at St Mary's and talked from the heart about what a difference our gifts made to our friends in Mandimba.



Our First Full Immersion Holy Baptisms in The River Thames

The sun certainly shone on us on Sunday 15 July when Ben led us across the road to the River Thames to conduct our first full-immersion baptisms. The service saw six of our church congregation, three young people, two adults and a baby, baptised and welcomed into the family of God.

On what was one of the hottest days of the year, hundreds of people congregated by the riverbank at the bottom of Benn's Alley to watch. They were a mixture of members of the church, the congregation and friends and family of the baptism candidates.

Ben was assisted by our Associate Priest, Reverend Alan Jackson in the baptisms, and John Soones, safety officer from the RNLI, was on hand to ensure the river was a safe place for the ceremony. Since his arrival at St Mary's

in June 2017, Ben has done much to grow the church into a young and vibrant place to worship at the heart of the local community and he commented, "Today sees our young adults and children follow in the footsteps of Jesus who was baptised in the river Jordan by John the Baptist. Baptism symbolises cleansing, reviving and is the symbol of new life, not just to the candidates but also for those who are present. It is also a way for the teenagers and adults to declare their beliefs publicly."

Baptism is a sacramental rite, in which a person pledges their allegiance to God through Jesus Christ and rejects everything which is not of God. 
